Igniting confidence in young people to pursue creative pathways and drive social change through the transformative power of media arts.

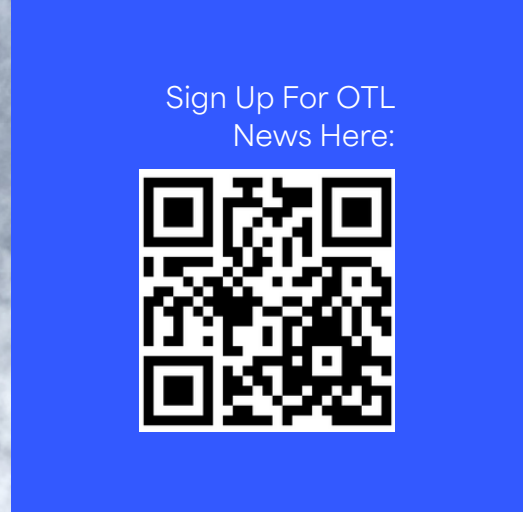
## OUR VISION
